A career guidance workshop was held on the 19th of April 2014. The resource person Ms Sandhya Limaya from DISHA counseling centre facilitated the session. 30 children (8th to 12th Std) from the Child Development centre, Creche and those covered under the Sponsorship Program attended. Specific pointers were given on the various degree and diploma courses that they could opt for. The session ended with individual guidance based on their plans for the future.

REAPing the benefits

In the last week of April, 10 teachers from Pre-school and Child Development Center attended a 5 day training workshop which was conducted by the trainers from Reach Education Action Programme (REAP). This training was very useful as trainers made all the teachers practice and demonstrate the use of all the new materials they have made and also suggested proper methods wherever needed. Teachers also learnt that they need to understand the psyche of the child in order to inculcate in them the different values and concepts.

Creative Handicrafts in association with the British Council (Delhi) conducted two trainings spanning over 6 days for women who are aspiring to begin or have already begun a small business. Aspects such as risk assessment, legal procedures, consumer and market behavior were discussed in simple terms. 50 women benefitted. Many of them have already begun businesses like jewellery, paper bag making and powder spices business.
